READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE TAKING TEST:

1. **GO** to the internet site of the placement test. It should not take more than 30 minutes.
2. **Start at the CCSF FL Dept website:** <http://www.ccsf.edu/forlang>
3. Choose “Placement and Prerequisites” (left hand navigation column)
4. Choose “Chinese”
5. Choose “ B. Placement Test”
6. Click on the link to go straight to the WebCAPE Placement test portal (will open in a new window).
7. Enter the Password: *california1*
8. Choose "Chinese" from the drop down menu.
9. Enter your information – Enter the special high school code (since you do not have a CCSF ID): 12345
10. Click **Submit Information**.
11. Follow the directions to take the test.
12. **SAVE YOUR RESULTS**. Save the results page as a PDF. Name it: *yourname-results.pdf*
Print it out. Bring your results with you to the 4/10 CCSF application session.
